# Tisbury Electric Car Club, Tisbury <br> A CASE STUDY WITH GUSTAVO, PROJECT LEAD. 

Tisbury Electric Car Club is a new project from Nadder Community Energy. Nadder Community Energy is based in the town of Tisbury in Wiltshire. They raise money for their local area by selling shares; this money is used to put solar panels or other renewable energy systems into the community.

Gustavo said: "The two Renault Zoe's, Elektra and Sparky, are used by our regular users who can now make their journeys that they couldn't do before. Allowing them to visit families, and friends and travel to activities in a much cheaper and environmentally way"

"Our membership continues to grow. We have a range of users, such as those who may have recently given up their second vehicle as well as those who do not own a personal vehicle anymore."

The chargepoints were part of the first Charge My Street installations and are ready to use by car club members or visitors of Tisbury. The chargepoints were installed as part of the SOSCI project, funded by Innovate UK.

"Although Tisbury is a small village, we have a busy high street with a range of independent businesses such as Coffee Angels, The Fish Mongers and The Messums art gallery to take advantage of whilst you charge. We have some idyllic local walks, one starting at the car park where the chargepoint is located, that takes in the local scenery such as water meadows, woodlands \& the river."
