Morland is a village and civil parish in the rolling hills of the Eden Valley in the Eden District of Cumbria, England. It lies within the historic county of Westmorland.

The village hall association got in contact with Charge My Street through the Charge My Street [website](#). The chargepoints were officially launched at the end of May 2021 by Daniel Heery, Director of Charge My Street as well as members of the village hall association.

Ian said "We thought the chargepoints would be a good facility for the village, there is a lot of housing without off-street parking, if anyone wanted to buy an Electric vehicle it would be very hard for them to charge it. We also have a lot of holidaymakers in the summer, we wanted to allow them to charge whilst visiting the village."




“We are currently looking at making the hall greener. We are considering replacing the boiler in the future with an air source heat pump. We are always looking for ways to become carbon neutral and the chargepoints are one way of achieving that”.
